The trophy was conceived and first presented in 1968 by founding President Bob Peacock to Tom Sommerville, long time Honorary Secretary of the club.

As the name suggests, the trophy was to recognise the contributions of individuals to the club over the previous year/s. By convention the awarding of the Club Man Trophy is at the sole discretion of the outgoing President for the particular year.

The choice by Bob Peacock of “Johnny Walker” as the flag bearer for the award is indicative of his approach to fellowship within the club and of his liking for the odd wee dram.

I think the trophy continues to give a message about the convivial spirit in which the club operates and I would hope that this same spirit continues into the future.
